Nuits Saint Georges - Domaine Henri Gouges 2021

A lovely, brilliant crimson colour. A very earthy Nuits nose with some vanilla bean, too. On the palate, smoky, velvet-textured fruit without any tannin, but acids take their place, so the wine is nicely balanced. Not heavy, but a very elegant Pinot expression at the end, perfect for fish & poultry dishes.

Margaux Chateau Kirwan, 2000, Grand Cru Classé

A highly-extracted, rich, medium-bodied wine with a deep ruby/purple colour & a ripe casis fruit intermixed with a touch of new oak, prunes & spine. The wine has come together nicely since I first tasted it from cask. It appears to be an excellent nearly outstanding effort, there is moderate tannin in the finish.

La Pèira

La Peira en Damaisela Les Terrasses du Larzac 2019

La Pèira is predominantly Syrah (from 25-year-old vines), with some Grenache (28-year-old vines). It comes from a plot called Bois de Pauliau, adjacent to the estate buildings, in the Terrasses du Larzac appellation. A unique wine, whose striking mineral dimension draws you in. Perfect to enjoy on its own or with a selection of cheese.

Gevrey Chambertin, Clos Du Fonteny, Bruno Clair 1er Cru 2021

Gorgeous damson and Victoria plum fruit crisp & sweet, wrapped in a dense silky texture. Smooth & sophisticated but also showing the heard & body you'd expect from Gevrey. Ripe but with a clarity & vitality that prolongs the finish.
